TIDBITS FOR THOUGHT

CENTERING ON GOD

Psalm 121:1-2 "I lift up my eyes to the hills---where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth."

The early church father, Augustine, once observed, "There can only be two basic loves, the love of God unto the forgetfulness of self, or the love of self unto the forgetfulness and denial of God.

I sometimes wonder how the life of each of us would be changed if we truly played to an audience of one.....if we unequivocally put God in the center of our lives at all times and in all ways... an incredible challenge for anyone. That would mean that you or I ask in every situation.....every lifestyle choice.....every conflict.....every relationship.....every worship experience, not what I want to do or what does the world expect me to do but what does God want me to do.

If I allow God to become the complete center of my life, some of the path may seem, at first, to be mysterious, cloudy and uncertain but on the other hand, some things become very evident. The sense of ego and the facade that I give to the world will fade because now I will not have to prove myself or justify my actions to others. The acceptance of the world will pale in comparison to pleasing God. My eyes will see everyone in a new and refreshing way, the way that Jesus sees them. My ears will hear the pain and confusion in the voices of people seeking meaning in their lives. My hands will reach out to assist the poor and needy. My life will model kindness at every turn. My heart will overflow with compassion and concern for those floundering in the darkness of sin. My moral outrage at the current despicable treatment of the stranger among us would demand that I

Speak up and speak out on their behalf, even at the risk of the slings and arrows of those who buy into the lies and misinformation that is spoken about them, despite any credible evidence. The same moral outrage would dictate that I would never allow words of bigotry and hate to go uncontested in my presence....no matter who vomits them into the world.

Everything that I do would take on a new meaning, even the simplest and most mundane acts of life. The worry and frets of my life will take a backseat to the joy of living the life that Jesus modeled for me. The joy in the life of one completely centered on God cannot help but attract the notice of those looking for peace and meaning in life.

I am not sure if there are enough words in the dictionary or that anyone on earth has the skill to use those words to fully express the incredible joy that might be found in living a life and a journey completely centered on God.....a journey of which we are all capable, if we so choose.
