TIDBITS FOR THOUGHT

THE GIFT OF THE SPIRIT

John 14: 15-16 “If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever.... the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.”

Throughout Scripture the image of the Spirit of God is described as fire.... wind...water...and many other beautiful images. But no matter how the Spirit is described, the overriding thought is one of connection to and being a piece of God. The mysterious concept of the Trinity tells us that the Father loves us unconditionally and because of that love, He sent The Son to redeem us and The Spirit to live within us. Scripture tells us that God gave us the Spirit that we might grow into Christians that embody the love that is God and enjoy the fruit that only a relationship with Him can provide. (Galatians 5:22-23)

The Spirit helps us find JOY in all things, even in times of grief and tragedy. He assists us to be at PEACE even in the tempest that might be flooding around us. His counsel shows us how to have PATIENCE when dealing with the annoying jot and tittle of life. KINDNESS becomes second nature when we allow Him to guide us through each and every day. GOODNESS shows itself in every action He prompts us to take in the name of Jesus. FAITHFULNESS in believing unequivocally in the words of Scripture is fortified by His insistence on truth. GENTLENESS becomes an integral part

of who we are when He prompts us to mirror Jesus to the world. Being led by Him assures us that SELF-CONTROL is possible in all things, great and small.

We might also find the Spirit leading us into places where we are not completely comfortable, such as when we are urged to confront and push back on lies that denigrate an individual or even an entire race of people. We might find our patience tested when dealing with bigotry or racism. We might find ourselves feeling anger instead of peacefulness when we see other people persecuted and harassed simply because they are from another country or worship in a different manner. We might be moved to reach out to assist the immigrant in spite of their daily persecution and denigration. In short, the Spirit could be using us to advance the Kingdom of God by insisting that the values of Jesus are not just good ideas on paper but a clear mandate on how to live and how to confront evil and how to assist the “others,” just as Jesus did. Even though this process might be scary, real faith tells us that if the Spirit leads us there and our motives are righteous, the Spirit will protect us there.

A church filled with individuals who display the fruit of the Spirit, even when tested, is a church that Jesus spoke of when He said, “A city on a hill cannot be hidden.” (Matthew 5:14)

Think about it.
