### *TIDBITS for THOUGHT*

#### WHAT IF?

Matthew 28:18-20 “Then Jesus came to them and said, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of age. “

With the above words, Jesus unleashed the most powerful movement that the world has ever witnessed. His words propelled a diverse group of individuals into the greatest adventure that any of them could fathom. He unchained them from the concept of “me” and injected them with the power of “we”. Each of His disciples were different and unique individuals but by the example of His leadership, they all became focused on one magnificent goal.... the goal of establishing the Lord’s church wherever they stood and wherever their voices could be heard and wherever their love of Christ could be seen. They worked toward this goal in spite of continual danger, dissenting voices, terrible living conditions and challenges that we can’t even begin to understand.

For over two thousand years this goal has propelled men and women of all ages, all occupations, all backgrounds and all temperaments to venture into unknown and unfriendly places of the world. The world has benefitted from the adventures of the many who established hospitals, fed the poor, ministered to the sick, and thousands upon thousands of mostly unknown and untold gifts of mercy.

What many modern-day Christians tend to forget is that we are His disciples, and that His admonition, His command,

His rousing cry is as applicable to us today as it was to the original twelve. We are just as responsible for the growth of our local church as Peter and Paul and others were for the newborn church depicted in the Book of Acts. “.....and the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.” Acts 2:47

We have been asked by the elders to pray daily for the growth and health of our fellowship. What if each of us, in addition to that prayer, would ask God to help us be Jesus to some individual today? What if we asked that He show us the widow or the single mother or struggling family who need assistance today? What if we asked that the Spirit would lead us to the one who is drifting aimlessly through life or point us to the spiritually bankrupt and spiritually hungry? What if we asked for the right words to motivate the serious seeker?

It is prayers such as these that have sparked revivals throughout the years. It is prayers such as these that help make the church a light in a dark world and an island of goodness in a putrid sea of evil.
