VICTORY FOREVER

John 16:33 “But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

*O victory in Jesus
My Savior forever
He sought me and bought me
With His redeeming blood
He loved me ere I knew Him
And all my love is due Him
He plunged me to victory
Beneath the cleansing flood*

Most everyone will recognize the above words as the chorus in the beloved hymn, “Victory in Jesus,” by Eugene Monroe Bartlett, better known as E.M. Bartlett. He wrote the song in 1939 while recovering from a stroke and it would prove to be the last gift that he left the Christian community, as he died in 1941. The hymn itself is a timeless message of hope and assurance, emphasizing the victory of believers through the blood of Jesus.

I have always admired and marveled at the pure genius it takes to set words to music in such a way that the message comes across clearly and profoundly..... truly a God given gift. With just a few well-chosen words Bartlett captured the very essence of Christianity.....the blood of Christ is what saves and redeems us and the shedding of that blood represents the highest expression of perfect love the Godhead could ever offer. It is a living testament to God's willingness to do whatever it took to make possible an eternal relationship with us.

hand of love and forgiveness to all we meet on a given day.
