TIDBITS FOR THOUGHT

THE DAY AFTER

Luke 2:11 “Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord.”

“When the song of the angels is stilled

When the star in the sky is gone

When the kings and princes are home

When the shepherds are back with their flocks

The work of Christmas begins:

To find the lost.... To heal the broken...To feed the hungry....

To release the prisoners.... To rebuild nations.... To bring peace among the people.... To make music in the heart.”

Excerpt from “The Mood of Christmas” Howard Thurman

I couldn't help but marvel at the simplicity of Thurman's words that convey a truth so very, very profound. The humble birth of Jesus was the center-piece of the most powerful movement to ever grace the history of mankind, yet it was but the prelude to a relentless journey that culminated in a disgraceful death and the incredible Resurrection that defeated death and sin itself. In between those momentous moments in time lie the work that Jesus proclaimed as His mission on this sad planet as related by the prophet Isaiah (61:1-2) “The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach

the good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captive and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn.”

When Jesus physically left our world, He left us with the Spirit to help us, as his hands, feet, eyes, ears and heart, to grow and fulfill His stated mission. So, as we ease into a new year, we might pray that we listen and heed the voice from the Spirit within that prompts us to reach out and help those who are less fortunate..... that screams at us to speak up and speak out whenever and wherever we encounter hate, bigotry, lies and injustice ... that alerts us to see clearly the needs of others and try to the best of our abilities to assist.... that urges us to listen closely to the cries of the broken hearted and grieving and then provide a listening ear and a compassionate heart..... that commands us to forgive more and judge less, just as Jesus did ... that stirs us to share more of our resources, both physical and spiritual..... that ignites the passion to share our experience, strength and hope with all who care to listen..... that softly proclaims and promises that, in spite all evidence to the contrary:

LOVE WILL HAVE THE LAST AND BEST WORD!
