TIDBITS FOR THOUGHT

GRATITUDE FOR TODAY

Psalm 100:5 “Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.”

Gratitude is one of the most powerful emotions with which the Lord blesses us. The very act of feeling grateful and expressing that gratitude is a soothing balm that can heal a hurting heart and stands as a joyful expression of freedom from the tyranny of want. Just the very act of waking up each morning and reminding ourselves, “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow.” (Hebrews 13:8) is reason enough to fall to our knees in gratitude and express that gratitude in worship and praise no matter what is going on around us on this earthly realm.

When we express our gratitude for what we have and for what God does for us, all of our challenges don't magically vanish. The illness might not leave us, the financial burdens might not be eased, the relationship might not be healed, the wayward child might not come home, or many of the trials that we face might not be solved, yet it is a great privilege and comfort to know that our God loves us forever and that His love will never change.....even to eternity.

Our love for Jesus and gratitude for His sacrifice is never more evident than when we extend, in His name, forgiveness and grace to another hurting soul. Our love for Jesus and gratitude for His forever love is never more visible than

when we reach out in His name to feed the hungry or clothe the poor. Our love for Jesus and all He stands for is never more obvious than when we extend aid and hospitality to the stranger among us.... sometimes at the risk of harsh words from others who are not so inclined. Our love for Jesus and admiration for His righteousness is never more apparent than when we confront lies and unfairness and bigotry and hate wherever we meet them.... sometimes at considerable personal risk. Our love for Jesus and gratitude for His sacrifice is never more manifest than when we reach out in kindness to a perfect stranger. Our love for Jesus and gratitude for His sacrifice is never more real and tangible than when we enrich another person with the message of salvation.

Our life as a Christian is never more powerful than when we truly give continual thanks to the Lord for our life and everything in it, even the challenges that sometimes seem so insurmountable.

In our weakness, we find His strength and love.....in His strength and love, we find our hope.....in our gratitude we celebrate that strength, love, and hope.

Think about it!
